Then read, explore and create all summer! Record your reading and other activities—such as visiting museums and parks—in your passport. When you check in each week at a Library location, you will get a prize, a stamp in your passport and an entry into a drawing to win one of our weekly prizes.

One weekly prize winner will be chosen at each location starting June 12. At the end of the summer, all weekly entries will be added to the grand prize drawing. Grand prize winners will be chosen Aug. 1. They will receive tickets to Coney Island. Each week has a theme to help guide your Summer Adventure.
